AUXILIARY 150 BY-LAWS

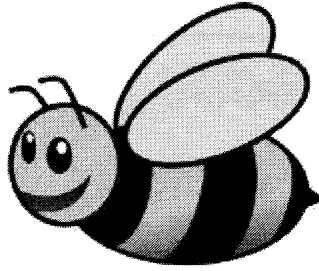

If you are not paid by May 31st, you only have 30 days or you will be delinquent and will be dropped from membership and have to re-enroll. If you are a beneficial member you will also lose your beneficial status. Please check your membership cards for this information.
