## DECEMBER BINGO KITCHEN CANCER FUND

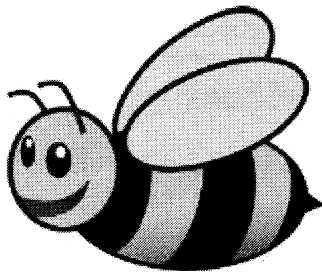
