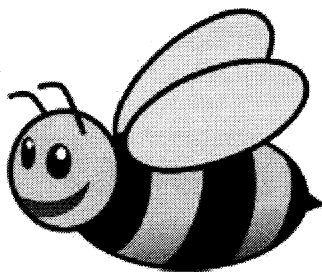

AUXILIARY SCHOLARSHIP FUND

The Auxiliary has raised enough money to give \$2,000 worth of scholarships our first year. Thank you to those that have participated in our fundraisers and for those that promoted our 1st year for the Auxiliary Scholarship Fund by scheduling events to raise this money.

Scholarships will be awarded to students who have demonstrated academic competence, community service and sound personal character throughout their high school/college career. These scholarships will be awarded to graduating seniors and/or current college students who meet the criteria as set forth in the application.

Eligibility requirements:

*Eligibility is limited to persons planning to attend an accredited college, university, school of higher learning (tech school), and/or on-line college courses.

*Candidate must have an affiliation such as self, parent or grandparent, step-parent, step-grandparent or legal guardian, who is a paid up member of our local FOE 150 Auxiliary.

*Applicant must have taken an active role in the community as well as school activities.

*Student must display good character and pride within the school and community.

The applications will be available at the Burlington Eagles Club by February 15th of each year. The completed application must be returned to the Auxiliary Scholarship Committee no later than April 1st.

NO EXCEPTIONS!

Recipients will be notified by the Auxiliary Scholarship Committee and will be awarded at the Auxiliary meeting held on the 1st Tuesday of June.
