ICE AND SNOW, TAKE IT SLOW

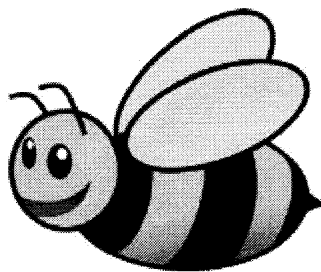
