ATTENTION

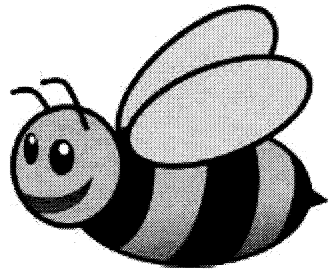
