PARADISE, CALIFORNIA BENEFIT

The Burlington Iowa Aerie and Auxiliary #150 held a benefit for the Paradise, CA Eagles #2960. The California fires in November of 2018 destroyed almost 19,000 structures including the Paradise Eagles building and some 400 member's homes. This fire took the lives of over 86 people. The Burlington Aerie understood how devastating it was for these members and raised money to be sent to the Paradise CA Eagles trust fund through the State of California Fraternal Order of Eagles.

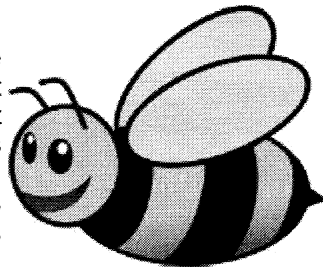
On the night of March 22nd, the Burlington Eagle Aerie and Auxiliary #150 had a meal, silent auction, meat raffles, 50/50 raffles and a band, LMNOP that raised over \$3,736 to send to our Aerie brothers and sisters in Paradise. This money was raised by having a Valentine dance that netted \$652, two money trees that raised \$870, meat raffles of \$309, the meal raised \$572, desserts \$49, Sunday Fundays, \$589, silent auction of \$675 and a member donation of \$20. Grand Aerie Trustee, Brian Rogers from the Sunnyslope Aerie #2957 from Phoenix, AZ was our speaker for the evening and told us a little about what was happening after the fires and thanked our Aerie and Auxiliary members for helping out their brothers and sisters in California.
