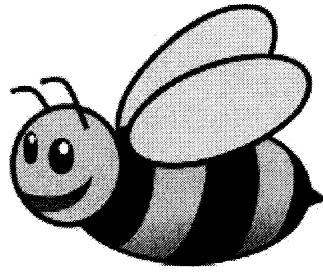
## CARD PARTY AT THE EAGLES
