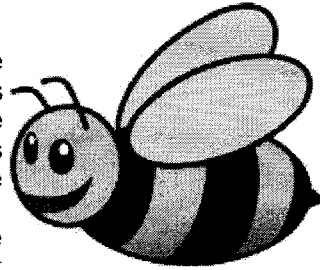
This is a benefit for our scholarship fund. The more money we raise the more scholarships we can give. Please bring your friends and neighbors.
